Alliance will not sell, share or release your name to any list service, outside organization or manufacturer, and any information provided by you will be held in the strictest of confidence. The Information We Collect

You may browse the Alliance website without submitting personal information. However, if you choose to participate in any of our online activities, you may be asked for applicable personal data such as your name, postal address, email address, phone number, and payment information. The purpose of collecting such data is to respond to specific questions, to register you to receive e-mail updates and other events that have online registration, to honor requests for brochures or newsletters or to process donations made online. Credit Card Security

When you donate to Alliance online, your credit card information is secured by a reputable security company, Authorize.Net, a leading payment gateway since 1996. The Authorize.Net Payment Gateway manages the complex routing of sensitive customer information through the electronic check and credit card processing networks. The company adheres to strict industry standards for payment processing.

Please note: www.allianceontheweb.org is registered with the Authorize.Net Verified Merchant Seal program.

Also, your credit card number is used only for that particular transaction and is not stored. You will see the “closed” lock symbol in either the status bar or address bar of your browser when you are on our secure donation pages. You will also notice in your browser’s address

bar that the URL starts with "https" on those donation pages. This means that information entered on those pages is encrypted for your security.
