To qualify, you must satisfy all of the requirements listed below:

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- 18 Years or older
  - GED or High School Diploma (or its *equivalency*)
  - Valid ID/TX Driver's License
  - Reliable Transportation
  - Speak, read, and write in English
  - Meet eligibility scores for the *Test for Adult Basic Education (TABE)*
- **Attend the program orientation & C.N.A orientation**
  - **Must be accepted as a client of the Financial Opportunity Center**
  - Possess a *clear criminal background*
  - Show records of the *Tuberculosis (TB) Skin Test*
  - **\$100 registration fee** Includes = Books + Training materials + CPR certification + Hospice training + State Exam registration

**September 5 – October 13, 2017**

**Training consists of two components, each are weeks in duration for a total of (6) six weeks:**

- ✚ **1<sup>st</sup> 3 weeks - Adult Education Training:** Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday, 9am – 12pm @ Alliance for Multicultural Community Services
  - “Soft Skills”, Job Readiness Preparedness, Financial Literacy Topics, C.N.A. Contextualized Vocabulary Terms, Introduction State Minimum Standards
